

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for services; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory, vault company and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses, parking lot and ground maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

OTHER PREPARATION OF THE BODY

- A. Dressing, cosmetizing and positioning of remains in casket
- B. Hairdresser
- C. Reconstructive restoration (per hour)
- D. Special care of autopsied remains
- E. Washing and disinfection of remains when no embalming

USE OF FACILITIES

- A. Shelter of remains per day
(This charge is made on the 4th day our facilities are used to shelter remains.)
- B. Facilities and staff for visitation (per hour)
Our services include set-up of visitation area, placement of encased remains, display of floral arrangements, supervision of and attendance during visitation.
- C. Use of facilities and staff services for funeral service or additional staff necessary for service in other facility
- D. Use of facilities and staff services for memorial service (without remains)
Our services include coordination of the memorial service arrangements, supervision of the memorial service and staff to attend service.
- E. Equipment and staff services for graveside services
Our services include accompaniment of remains to cemetery, supervision of graveside service and staff to attend service.
- F. Refrigeration charge for unembalmed remains

(In addition to charge referred to in subsection "A" per day)

- G. Schedule for Witness or ID at Crematory
- H. Cremation Expedite Fee

DIRECT CREMATION

Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant, rites or ceremonies, includes removal of remains, local transportation to crematory, necessary services of staff and authorizations. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are Heavy Cardboard, Utility, Minimum, Pinehurst, Faith, Cub Fiera, Glenwood, Rosemont, Frontier and Carter/Fremont.

- A. Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser
- B. Direct cremation with alternative container
- C. Direct cremation with casket selected from our funeral home
- D. Cremation fee (already included in direct cremation)

IMMEDIATE BURIALS

Our charge for an immediate burial without any attendant rite or ceremonies, includes removal and shelter of remains, local transportation to the cemetery, necessary services of staff and authorizations.

- A. Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser
- B. Immediate burial with cloth covered wood casket
- C. Immediate burial with casket selected from our funeral home
(In addition to cost of casket)

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes removal of remains, necessary services of staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, and local transportation to airport. This charge does not include visitation, rites or ceremony prior to forwarding of the body.

- A. With minimum shipping container
- B. With casket selected from our funeral home
(In addition to cost of casket)
- C. Air Tray

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME

This charge includes temporary shelter of remains, transportation of remains to cemetery and necessary services of staff. This charge does not include visitation, rites, or ceremonies.

ANATOMICAL DONATION

This charge includes basic services of staff, transfer of remains to funeral home, arterial embalming, necessary authorizations and transportation to the Anatomical Board in Gainesville, Florida. This charge does not include any visitation, rites, or ceremonies.
